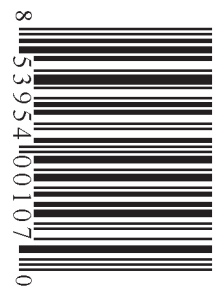

## Swizzle stick collectors prefer things stirred not shaken

Are you one of those people who eagerly takes home the stir stick from your cocktail rather than tossing it? You are in good company. Those little plastic sticks are becoming sought-after pieces of bar memorabilia and some collectors have tens of thousands of them!

A little background is in order. What people often call a “swizzle stick” may not actually be one. Swizzle sticks have a bit of a different lineage than modern stir sticks and both differ from the smaller, less ornate garnish skewer.

Still, we are probably all in the same glass as the stick in your Sidecar can be traced to the 1600s in the colonial West Indies. Pronged branches of aromatic bushes like allspice and more commonly an evergreen known as Quararibea Turbinata (which became known as the “Swizzlestick Tree”) were used with a swishing motion to froth drinks. In his 1920s book, “A Guide to the West Indies, Bermuda and Panama,” naturalist writer Frederick Albion Ober described the swizzle and swizzling: “The stem of a native plant with radiating twigs, or roots...is revolved rapidly between the palms of the hands.” He added, “The combined action of the motion and a peculiar saponaceous quality of the twigs... produces a delicious froth.”

The tool was often used to blend a beverage called a “Switchel,” common across the Caribbean, made with molasses and water. Then came a popular cocktail known as a rum swizzle made with Bermuda rum, water, and various flavorings, then “swizzled” into a chilled and frothy libation. Many of today’s bartenders are familiar with the category of cocktails known as swizzles, like the Queen’s Park, that involve the use of the stick and method described.

By the 19th-century, the tool had developed some unflattering connotations. In Victorian England, another stick, typically made of glass, was employed by the Queen and members of English society to stir the carbonation out

of Champagne, thus preventing any rather “unladylike emissions” later. The 1890s Century Dictionary described the term “swizzle” to reflect a blending of the words swill and guzzle. The definition also referenced drinking habitually and to excess.

The modern chapter of the swizzle stick’s story starts in 1934. Boston inventor Jay Sindler, finding himself unable to fish the olives out of his martini without using his fingers, concocted the idea of a wooden spear, with a small paddle at the upper end that could be printed with an establishment’s name. He called it a swizzle stick even though it was intended for spearing garnishes rather than swizzling a drink. He formed a company

called Spir-it.

One of the first promotional uses of Sindler’s wooden swizzle sticks was for Eldorado Rum. As Prohibition had just ended, other brands and drinking establishments quickly followed suit. They were all thirsty to get their names and locations in front of the public. Wood, glass, and even Bakelite sticks were quickly crafted to fill the demand.

After World War II, the advancement of plastic injection molding allowed swizzle makers to offer increasingly creative options. The most basic sticks featured simple printing, like business names on the handles or logos on the paddle at the top. Yet, many employed clever imagery like the swordfish and lobsters employed

on swizzles at seafood restaurants, airplanes and globes on sticks from airlines, and even the Playboy bunny atop the swizzles used in the clubs.

Establishments were constantly trying to outdo each other with creative pieces. By the 1950s and 60s — the halcyon decades for their use — the humble swizzle stick had turned into a powerful tool for visual marketing. Businesses encouraged patrons to take swizzles home as mementos, knowing that it would help reinforce the brand. In that sense, swizzles served a role very similar to branded matchbooks that were also employed as

## Indiana stoneware and coverlets soar high at Davies auction

Lafayette, Ind. — Years ago unless a piece of furniture, stoneware, or textile originated from the eastern portion of the U.S., collectors — let's be honest — turned up their noses. Not anymore. Pieces from the South and Midwest have now acquired their own legion of advocates with Indiana items also having a strong fan-base.

Regionalism was in full force at the online-only Davies Auctions' held Oct. 14 with early American country furniture, early Indiana stoneware, Indiana coverlets, early lighting, country accessories, toys, primitives, general store items, Civil War era autographs, and the like selling strong.

"The stoneware, coverlets, cherry furniture, and early lighting were from the collection of Ken and the late Donna Almon of Indianapolis with the rest of items being from a variety of consignors," said auctioneer Doug Davies.

Indiana stoneware continues to gain momentum in the marketplace. Such pieces have that organic utilitarianism collectors love. Where before such everyday pieces might have been overlooked, they now are both hard to find and eagerly snatched up when they surface.

An 8-gallon early stoneware semi-ovoid jar wearing an impressed "8" and "Manufacturer of A. & L. Uhl, Evansville, Ind. 20" was estimated to bring between \$100 and \$200, but instead required the winning bidder

pony up \$3,300. Prices do not include the 15 percent buyer's premium. At its widest point, the diameter of the jar was 13 inches and it stood 20 inches tall.

Impressed with "Martin Stuckey" and with a scratched in number "6", this 6-gallon stoneware jar from Loogootee, Martin Co., Indiana, also sold strong realizing \$2,500.

Other Indiana stoneware of note include a 4-gallon ovoid jar from Parke County, Indiana, wearing the impressed mark of "D.L. Atcheson, Annapolis, IA". Atcheson start-

ed his pottery in 1841 and died in 1853. This 15-inch tall and 11 inch in diameter (at its widest point) jar sold for \$1,100. "IA" is an earlier state abbreviation for Indiana.

A 1-gallon, 10-inch tall, ovoid stoneware jug impressed "Annapolis, IA" along with an impressed star, another Parke Co., Indiana, piece brought \$1,000.

Indiana decorative arts were also represented. A four-color Indiana, two-piece coverlet by William Deeds, Pipe Crick, Harrison Twp. Miami County, Ind., and dated 1857

sold for \$2,200 against a \$600-\$800 estimate. Having a rooster border and fringe on three sides, this coverlet measured 72 inches wide by 87 inches long.

"I was surprised by the number of people bidding on the coverlets; actually, more than those bidding on the stoneware," Davies said. "The condition of the coverlets was good, so that was a major factor."

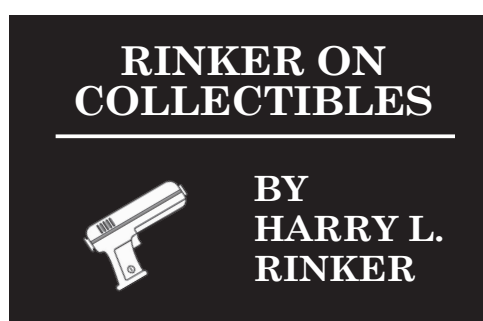

## Cockatoos a popular Art Nouveau motif

**Q** I recently came across a cockatoo wall pocket signed by Delphin Massier, a French potter. I spent hours trying to find an identical example online. I could not find one anywhere. I did see a rooster head wall pocket signed by Massier. What would be a reasonable value for a cockatoo wall pocket?

**A** Delphin Massier (1836-1907) was a member of the Massier family, a dynasty of ceramists established by Pierre Massier (1707-1748) in Vallauris, France. Pierre Massier was succeeded by Jacques Massier (1806-1871) who was responsible for giving the Massier workshop a new lease on life by expanding its production from simple utilitarian ceramics to innovative and artistic art ceramics. Italian potter Gondolfi Gaetano arrived in 1859. He trained Delphin and his brother Clément (1844-1917).

When Jacques died in 1871, Delphin and Clément inherited the firm. Their cousin Jerome (1830-1915) joined the



firm. Eventually, the brothers separated and moved to different locations within Vallauris. Jerome's son Jean Baptiste Massier gained control of the initial workshop site. He produced polychrome enameled faience destined for use in the garden or home.

Massier family production peaked at the turn of the 20th century. Massier issued elaborate sales catalogs picturing its merchandise. The catalogs allow the identification of Massier molds as well as showcasing the diversity of its products.

Massier produced pieces that were representative of popular period design styles. At the end of the 19th century, Delphin and Jerome devoted their de-

sign efforts to Art Nouveau. The cockatoo was a popular Art Nouveau motif.

Freeman's, a Philadelphia auction firm, offered a Delphin Massier majolica swallow wall pocket at its January 28, 2020 auction. It sold for \$552.50. WorthPoint.com's Worthopedia has a listing for an identical example that brought \$229.50 on eBay on October 25, 2020.

Worthopedia also contained a listing for a Delphin Massier cockatoo head wall pocket that realized \$519.00 on eBay on December 3, 2007. Because molds were created, this is most likely the piece you came across.

Given the above, your cockatoo head wall pocket has a secondary market value between \$500 and \$560. Secondary market demand for Delphin Massier three-dimensional animal figures and many vases is much higher.

**Q** I inherited a deep oval, pinkish glazed bowl, possibly a centerpiece bowl, from my parents. They lived in Santa Monica, California, when they acquired

it. The inscribed mark on the bottom reads: "WINDFIELD / 418 / PASADENA." There is a penciled "9" to the right of the "418." I have no idea what this means. What history and value can you provide for my bowl?

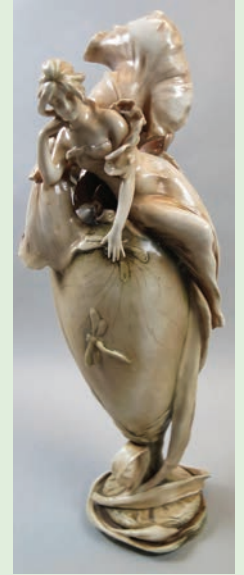
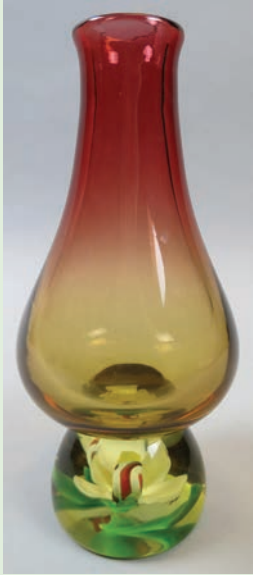

Mary Rufinia (1881-1959) sold for \$1,600. Rufina was a Catholic nun who painted and gave lessons in the Lafayette, Ind., Diocese. This oil on Masonite work measured 25 inches by 30 inches.

Furniture offered at this October auction did not necessarily come from the Midwest. A Southern cherry sugar chest having a dovetailed case, dovetailed drawer, interior divider, and lock with an inlaid escutcheon was bid to \$1,500. It stood 34 inches tall. And a diminutive (at 42 inches high) walnut jelly cupboard with two dovetailed drawers and poplar side came in at \$1,300.

Another surprise for Davies was the lot of insulators that sold strong. "These were part of the Almon's things, and I was not really sure if they would be noticed," Davies said. "I was wrong about that."

A lot of seven glass and four pottery insulators sold for \$650 against an estimate of \$20 to \$50. Included in the lot were two Mickey Mouse style insulators in aqua and green marked Hemingray, one cobalt blue glass example, one white pottery piece marked Lapp 1928 and two 6-inch-tall green glass pieces to name a few.

"We had 600 bidders registered for this auction, and we continue to do very well selling only online," Davies notes. "I believe holding on-line only sales will be how we continue to do our auctions since we have done well for our consignors doing so."

Company, was founded in 1929. Originally located in Pasadena, California, Winfield Pottery moved to Santa Monica in 1946.

Winfield's primary product line was dinnerware, the most frequently encountered Winfield product when researching the company on the internet. In addition to dinnerware, Winfield made tabletop decorative accessories, such as bowls and ashtrays. Most were glazed with a single color or two colors – one on the outside and the second on the inside. These pieces were similar in design to tabletop decorative accessories made by rival west coast potters such as Bauer.

Your pinkish color sings early 1950s, when charcoal and pink were popular household and fashion colors. "418" is the mold number used to create the bowl. The "9" most likely represents a secondary market sale price. Nine dollars is far too high a price for this piece in the 1950s.

In 1946, the American Ceramic Company, also located in Santa Monica, bought the rights to manufacture some of the Winfield patterns. Hence, American Ceramic Company's "Gabriel" trademarked pieces are identical to the patterns on Winfield dinnerware. Winfield Pottery ceased operations in 1962, one of the many victims of cheap foreign imports and the rising popularity of plastic dinnerware.

My internet research revealed limited information about non-dinnerware Winfield pieces. I found a few references to Winfield's Duotone [two colors – one inside, one outside] line. I also found Winfield dinnerware pieces that had the same pink glaze found on your bowl. Using these prices for comparison purposes, a fair secondary market value for your bowl west of the Rockies is \$12 to \$15 and east of the Rockies \$8 to \$10.



**Q** I acquired a Paine Furniture Company wall shelf. It consists of three shelves. The second and third shelves are separated by Colonial-style, lattice work sides. The back of the bottom shelf is marked "43.7083." Other than needing a good cleaning and having some scratches, it is in excellent condition. I am trying to determine its worth.

**A** The Paine Furniture Company was a large furniture company/store located in Boston. The first floor of its building, with entrances on Arlington, Stuart, and St. James, contained the lobby and retail sales gallery. The upper



floors featured showrooms for accessories, bedding, draperies, furniture, and rugs in addition to manufacturing, repair, and upholstery areas. In addition to producing its own brand name furniture, Paine Furniture also sold furniture made by other manufacturers.

No one is going to collect 50 wall shelves, albeit I know individuals who own a dozen or more. The latter use them to display their smalls. The value of your wall shelf is a combination of decorative value (a welcome accessory for a Colonial Revival room setting) and reuse (functional no matter in what decorative setting it is used).

The fact that it was made by or sold by Paine adds no additional value.

If it needs a good cleaning and has scratches, it is not in excellent condition. Even after you clean it and fix the scratches (use a furniture renew kit available at Big Box and smaller hardware stores), its condition is closer to very good. The best way to describe the finished shelf is "room ready," meaning it is ready to hang on the wall without anything further needing to be done to it.

As it stands, the value of you wall shelf is around \$25. After you have cleaned it up and fixed the scratches, its value increases to \$40..

**Q** I own two sets, one with blue and the other with red decals, of four Moravian historical cups and saucers. The decals contain images of John Hus, David Nitschmann, a chalice, and the great seal of the Moravian Church. The back is marked "Lamberton Scammell." I am moving and no longer appreciate them. What is your advice?

**A** These cups and saucers along with a series of a dozen plates were designed to appeal to members of the Moravian faith and sold primarily

in the vicinity of Bethlehem, Pennsylvania, and Winston-Salem, North Carolina. When the initial production was exhausted, the Moravian Bookstore in Bethlehem worked with Lamberton to reissue the series.

WorthPoint.com's Worthopedia has more than 15 listings for Moravian historical cup and saucer pairs. There appears to be no price difference between the two colors. A cup and saucer pair has a sell through value on eBay between \$15 and \$20. Replacements, Ltd. has one red cup and saucer pair in stock with a list price of \$19.99, reduced from \$29.99. It has seven different red center decal Moravian dinner plates from the series with an asking price between \$33.99 or \$29.99 depending on the center view.

Your Moravian cups and saucers have minimal to no value to someone who is not a member of the Moravian faith. Those that own them tend to display or store them rather than use them, thus diminishing any interest by younger Moravians.

Unless you live in the vicinity of Bethlehem or Winston-Salem, chances of selling a paired cup and saucer set for over \$4 is slim. In the former areas, an expectation of \$8 to \$10 a set is possible.

My recommendation is to donate them to the Moravian Archives in Bethlehem, ask them to sell them in their gift shop, and credit the proceeds to the Archives as a donation from you.

# Fenton and Galle duke it out for top honors at Woody auction

DOUGLASS, Kan. – A 9 ¾-inch-tall blown mold French cameo glass vase signed Galle and a Fenton mosaic art glass pedestal vase each knocked down for \$6,600 to share top lot honors at the sale of the private collection of Dr. Peter and Grace Jochimsen, held Oct. 23 by Woody Auction, online and live in the Woody Auction hall located at 130 East Third Street in Douglass.

The Galle vase was of the highest quality and featured white, yellow and green tones, with a green cameo carved vine and blossom décor. The Fenton pedestal vase, unmarked, was made from mosaic art glass and boasted beautiful colors. Made circa 1925, the vase featured most of the original Fenton label.

“We were really pleased with how well the four Newcomb pieces did,” said Jason Woody, the owner of Woody Auction. “The Fenton mosaic art glass was also exciting to auction. It went far above our estimates. Overall, the Jochimsen collection was enormous. We will be selling more of his antiques in our Dec. 18 online-only auction. Collectors need to mark their calendars. The date isn’t far off.”

Another signed Galle vase – a lovely example of French cameo art glass, with blown mold cherry branch décor, yellow and white ground with finely cameo carved cranberry overlay, 11 ¼ inches tall, finished at \$4,750. Also, an unmarked Royal Flemish by Mt. Washington vase, having a nicely segmented background with griffin and dragon enamel décor, fetched \$3,000.

An unmarked Wave Crest art glass plaque, showing a scene of a young woman in a pink dress, housed in the original 15 ½ inch gilt metal frame with the original backing, reached \$4,888. Also, a rare, unmarked Wave Crest cameo carved jewelry box, an example of the highest quality art glass, with a lake and tree scenic décor, 3 ¼ inches by 6 inches, garnered \$2,750.

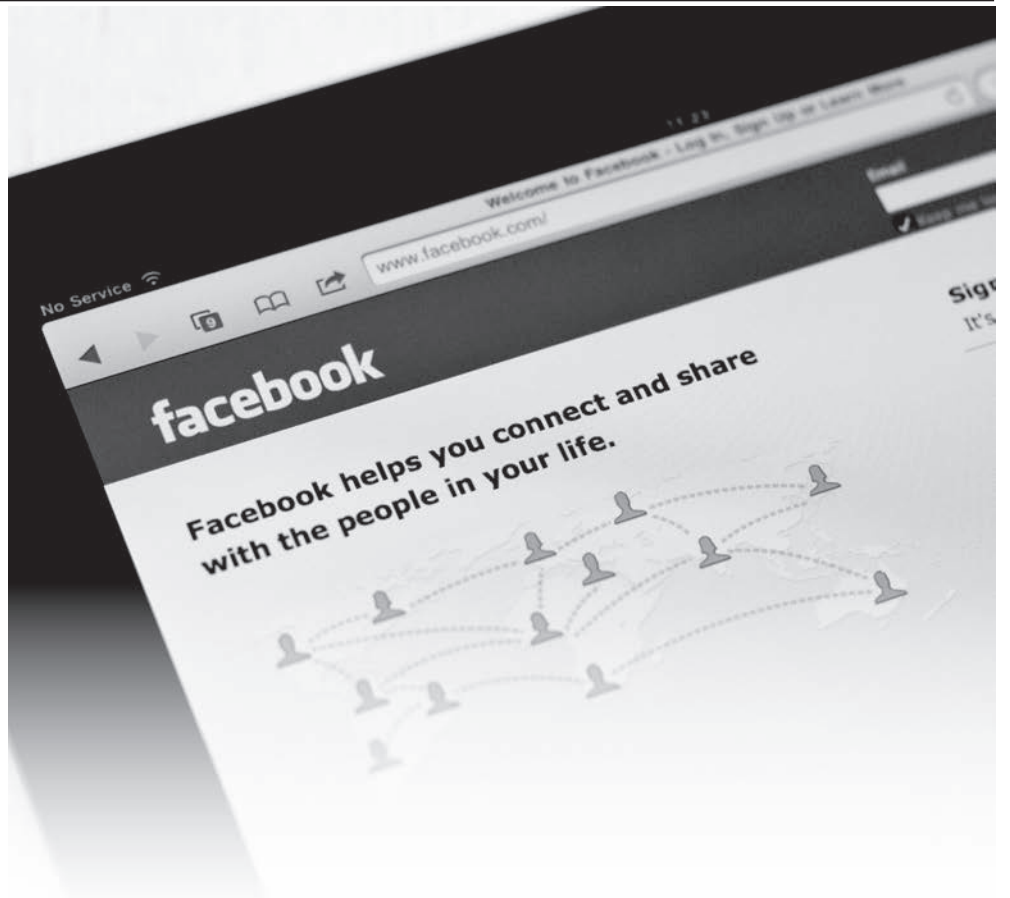

# Swizzle Sticks

By the 1970s, the need for custom swizzle sticks began to wane, as wine and beer started to overtake harder spirits as the libation of choice. As people became more health-conscious in the 1980s, most imbibing was discouraged, and bar margins got thin. Like matchbooks, bar and restaurant operators realized they could easily cut the frill of fancy swizzle sticks from their budgets.

Interest in cocktails started reblooming in the late 1990s, thanks to shows like "Sex and the City" and its penchant for the Cosmo. Classic cocktail culture was solidly replanted in the early 2000s when "Mad Men" took viewers back to the era when the cocktail hour was commonplace. A craft cocktail scene soon began spreading across the country, with craft bars bringing back swizzle sticks as promotional tools.

The affair with craft cocktails spawned a home bar resurgence, often connected to the parallel retro revival. Today, amateur mixologists don cocktails with vintage swizzle sticks, attempting to connect with another place and time. When not using vintage pieces, home barkeeps will drop in an imaginative modern one, indirectly reinforcing today's brands the same way it happened sixty years ago.

That is good news for companies like Spirit Foodservice — Jay Sindler's original Spir-it in its modern incarnation — which is the largest producer of stir sticks in the world. According to Joe Pierro, vice president of sales and marketing, "Today we produce several billion a year." Its main rival, Indiana-based Royer Corporation produces pieces for noteworthy entities including the Greenbriar Resort and the Hotel Monteleone in New Orleans.

Whether vintage or modern, plentiful supply means collecting swizzle sticks is more about enjoyment than value. While some rare pieces from long-gone establishments have sold for two and occasion-

ally three figures, it is very common to find jars filled with dozens selling for under \$10.

Most swizzle stick collectors have a preferred category such as those from airlines, theme parks, or tiki bars. So, there is a certain thrill of the hunt, trying to locate pieces to add to a collection. Many will buy bags or jars of swizzle sticks just to cherry-pick the ones they want. Condition is rarely an issue since most swizzles were used only once.

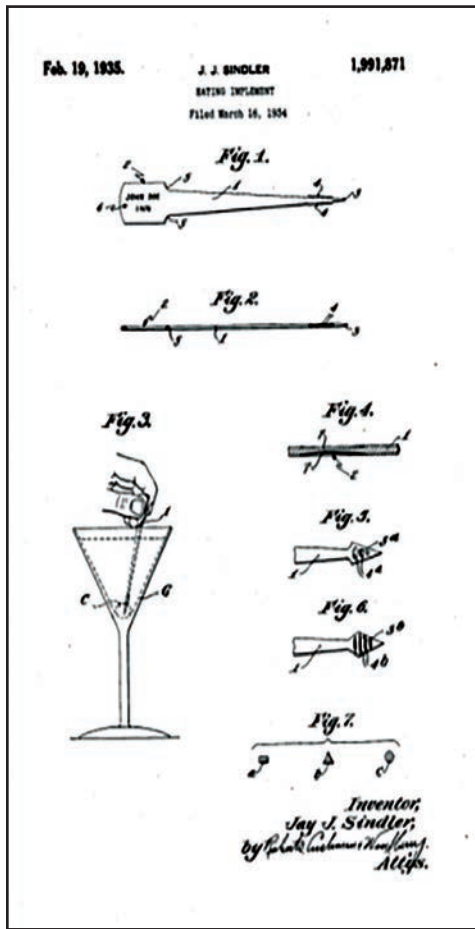
If you turn into a serious junkie, there is the Swizzle Stick Collectors Club (swizzlestickcollectors.com) founded in 2019, an offshoot of an earlier group the International Swizzle Stick Collectors Association, founded three decades earlier.

In an era when many modern watering holes use little red coffee stirrers in cocktails, it's good to know there was — and still is — something more artistic to embellish a drink. The treasure-trove of vintage swizzles and the imaginative modern ones are a legacy — and a cocktail's most fashionable accessory.

### West India Swizzle

This is an old-fashioned Cocktail, simple to make and very popular in the West Indies :

Use large mixing glass.

½ wineglass of Gin, Whisky, Brandy or Rum (see page 8), as preferred.

3 or 4 generous dashes of Angostura Bitters.

¼ to 1 teaspoonful of Syrup, as preferred.

Pour these into a tall mixing glass, add an equal quantity of cold water or cracked ice and, with a swizzle-stick, swizzle to a froth. Serve in a Cocktail glass or small tumbler.

If ice is used, add also a little water. In this way the foam is created more quickly and is more lasting. If preferred, this Cocktail can be served "still," i.e., not swizzled but well stirred.

#### "SWIZZLE-STICKS"

In the West Indies the Cocktail described above is mixed by the swizzle-stick method.

The swizzle-stick (illustrated alongside) is a natural product of the West Indies. It consists of the dried stem of a plant having radiating branches.

When the stem is twirled rapidly between the palms of the hands the forked branch-ends induce a perfect mixture of drinks.

An egg-whisk of the rotating type, if not used too vigorously, will serve quite well.

Rum, a home product, is a preferred drink in the West Indies. It appears prominently in "Swizzles." There is something naturally stimulating and nourishing about this wholesome spirit made from cane sugar. Who has not heard of the heartening bounty in Winter-time of "Rum and Milk," "Rum and Butter," "Egg Nog" and "Long Life"? (See index for recipes—see also Rum note on page 8.)
