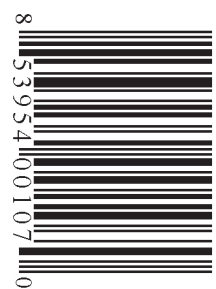


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You can be a Pepper too when you collect Dr. Pepper memorabilia

Charles Courtice Alderton studied at the University of Texas Medical Branch with the intention of making a difference in the world of medicine. But fate had other ideas. Alderton would instead go on to make history in the world of soft drinks.

After graduation, Alderton began working as a pharmacist at the W.B. Morrison & Co. Old Corner Drug Store in Waco, Texas. The pharmacy featured a soda fountain and the 28-year-old began to experiment with the ingredients at hand. On December 1, 1885, he served a customer a concoction he had come up with, containing 23 ingredients mixed with the sharp tang of phosphoric acid. When Morrison tasted the beverage, he decided to call it Dr. Pepper and put it on the menu. A handful of theories exist as to how he came up with the name, but there is no evidence to support any of them.

The enjoyment of Dr. Pepper was experienced only by Morrison's customers until the 1904 World's Fair in St. Louis, when it was introduced and embraced by the masses. Two years later, the Artesian Manufacturing and Bottling Company was constructed at 300 South 5th Street in Waco, Texas, for the purpose of bottling Dr. Pepper. The facility bottled

the beverage until the 1960s. Dr. Pepper was initially advertised as a health drink which aided digestion and restored vitality. A blend of artificial and natural flavors, its recipe remains a trade secret but is rumored to include the flavors of licorice, amaretto, cherry, vanilla, apricot, pepper and several others. In 1936, a Dr. Pepper bottling plant opened on McClanahan Street in Roanoke, Va. Less than two decades later, Roanoke was known as "The Dr. Pepper Capitol of the World," breaking records for consumption of the beverage. The plant was demolished in 1997 after business was

relocated elsewhere. The town continues to celebrate "Dr. Pepper Day" every October 24.

During the 1960s, the period following "Dr" was omitted from the name for stylistic reasons. That same decade, Dr Pepper became a co-sponsor of the Miss Teenage America beauty pageant. In 1963, after a nationwide hunt for the perfect "Dr. Pepper girl," the company selected singer and actress Donna Loren as a spokesperson for the soft drink. Loren promoted Dr. Pepper on the radio, on television, in print and in person.

In 1977, lyricist Jake Holmes wrote the iconic jingle "I'm a pepper, he's a pepper, she's a pepper, we're a pepper, wouldn't you like to be a pepper too?" Through catchy advertising and an always expanding catalog, Dr Pepper

reached its intended audience again and again. Dr. Pepper began catering to those who wanted their beverages caffeine-free, sugar-free or diet. It kicked up its flavor with cherry vanilla, berries and cream, and creamy coco-nut. Other companies even jumped on the Dr.

Windmill salesman sample blew in with \$20,000 bid at Chupp

SHIPSHEWANA, Ind. - Chupp Auctions comes up with the neatest sales and the Friday, September 19 and Saturday, September 20 auctions were no different.

Day One was packed with unique antiques, advertising, farm primitives, toys, and hard to find collectibles. Saturday highlights included fabulous vintage petroleum and soda signs, country store pieces like coffee grinders and seed counters, plus unique toys, lamps, and even a Winchester cannon.

The top lot of Friday's sale was the salesman sample of a Butler Mfg. Co. wooden windmill which sold for \$20,000. Prices do not include the 17 percent buyer's premium if purchased through Chupp's online platform. Decorated with great stenciling and color, the windmill was marked on the base "by Beard Mfg Co. of Angola, Indiana," then on the fantail; one side was stenciled "BUTLER MFG. CO., BUTLER, IND." and on the other side just the word, "BUTLER."

Other salesman samples that sold strong include a 24 inch wide by 24 inch long reaper with brass wheels and a maker's tag for "C.M. Clinton, Model Maker, Ithaca, NY." Though it had been repainted it still brought \$9,000. A salesman sample of a hay spear measuring a whopping 17 inches long was bid to \$8,500, while a World Champion Corn Sheller #2 salesman sample wearing a patent of March 24, 1891 brought \$6,000. It measured 12 inches high.

Graphically appealing was the 48 by 58 inch "Domino Feeds" sign featuring a man carrying a sack of feed with the image of the man being made out of domino tiles. It sold for \$9,000.

Large in size at 59 by 34 inches was the SST Minneapolis Moline die-cut sign for "Mech & Sons Implt Co., Marshfield, Wis." that realized \$4,750. It was mounted on a wood back frame.

Day Two saw fantastic advertising signage taking top honors. Finding vin-

tage neon signs in great working condition with their glass tubing intact is no easy feat. Though it was a very basic sign with the neon simply spelling out “OFFICE” the 27 inch by 7.5 inch example was highly desired by at least two people being bid to \$10,000.

Condition was a major factor where the final bids garnered for advertising items offered up on Day Two. A great example was the self-framed Francisco Auto Heater sign. In fabulous condition with great automobile graphics, this stunner reached \$7,000. Likewise, the embossed Lee Overalls sign with detailed boxing graphics fought its way to \$5,250 with ease.

Other advertising pieces earning strong final bids included a self-framed “Mobilgas Just Ahead” 46 by 48 inch sign with a Pegasus graphic that reached \$5,500, and the “Devoe Paints” sign with a metal wall-mount frame that brought \$4,750 despite some porcelain chips.

And about that cannon? Well, it wasn’t a full-size cannon, but a Winchester breech loading cannon in its original wooden crate that measured 19 ½ by 8 by 8 ½ inches. The cannon takes 10 gauge blanks, and it sold for \$2,500.

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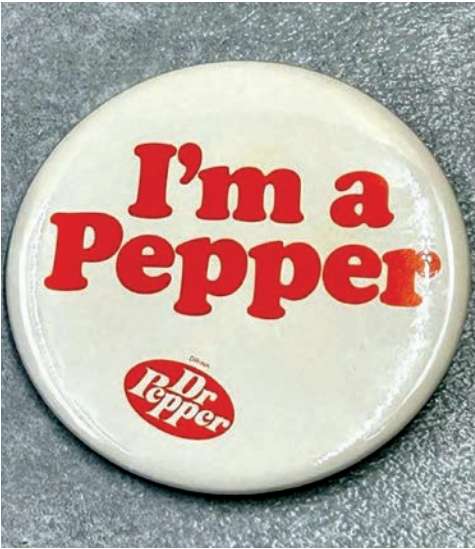
Dr. Pepper Memorabilia

Pepper bandwagon. Hubba Bubba began to produce Dr. Pepper-flavored bubble gum. Jelly Belly manufactures Dr Pepper-flavored jelly beans. Bonne Bell offers Dr Pepper-flavored lip balm. And Vita Foods produces Dr. Pepper Cherry Dessert Topping.

Dr. Pepper has become the second highest selling soft drink in America, following on the heels of Coca-Cola. In 2018, the company was acquired by the Keurig Company and evolved into Keurig Dr. Pepper. In 2023, its net sales for Dr. Pepper amounted to approximately \$15-billion. In 2024, it had the highest volume sales in the nation. As of October 2025, the company's revenue was over \$15-billion. As they say, there's something in the sauce, and that something calls generation after generation to wrap their fingers around a can of cold Dr. Pepper.

Today, Dr. Pepper has its own collector's club, which includes approximately 10,000 people. There is also a Dr. Pepper Bottles Database, with over 1,100 Dr. Pepper bottles displayed alongside information on value. And then there is the impressive museum. After the bottling company in Waco shut its doors during the 1960s, it reopened in 1991 as The Dr. Pepper Museum. Housing over 100,000 artifacts and a full archive, the facility has welcomed over three million visitors, setting a record in 2024 with 256,796 ticket-buyers. "The Dr. Pepper Museum has a way of

connecting people," said Autumn Outlaw, Director of Marketing & Development at the Museum. "It's nostalg-ic, it's fun, and it's uniquely tied to Waco. There's something about that one-of-a-kind taste that instantly takes people back, and everyone can think of a moment in their life that's tied to their favorite Dr. Pepper. Visitors might come for the drink they love, but they leave with a deeper appreciation for the creativity, history and community that made it possible. The museum brings that story to life in a way that feels personal, and people see their own memories reflected in it." At the museum, visitors can step up to the soda fountain and order a drink off the menu, such as a Dr. Pepper float. At the gift shop, tee shirts, buttons, stickers, ornaments – all baring the Dr. Pepper logo – can be purchased.

For those seeking merchandise with a longer backstory, there are auctions, antique stores, flea markets and yard sales. Limited edition unopened cans of Dr. Pepper are going for over \$2,500. Vintage advertising signs are in the \$5,000 range. Vintage print ads touting the peppery soft drink from magazines can be had for a couple dollars while vintage Dr. Pepper bottle caps are going for a little over \$3 each.

Among rare Dr. Pepper collectibles is a

1943 promotional cardboard game. Reading "Compliments of the Dr. Pepper Bottling Co.," the item features a dart game on one side and a ball dart game on the opposite side. Vintage hats, uniforms and name tags once utilized by Dr. Pepper employees are also rare. Employee name tags are priced around \$102 while hats and jackets are going for about \$300.

Rare advertising items include wooden sandwich sticks from the 1940s-era. Depicting a man with a hat and eye-glasses at the top, the sticks are stamped with the words "Dr. Pepper" and were used by restaurants to hold the two sides of a sandwich together. Collector Deanna Young of Texas has a collection of Dr. Pepper sandwich sticks in-herited from her aunt. "She worked in downtown Mobile, Alabama and saved them all those years," Young said. "She would often eat lunch at the Kress 5 and 10 cents soda counter while she worked at a local department store where she was working in the alterations department. She was born in 1923 and she was just a teenager at the time."

Remnants of the "Be a Pepper" campaign of 1977 can be found at auctions and flea markets in the form of "I'm A Pepper" tee-shirts and buttons – a fad that lasted until the 1980s. Bottle openers, ice chests, clocks and thermometers are other items in the Dr. Pepper franchise that can be found at shops and sales.

Charles Alderton died on May 29, 1941. Having planted the seed that would create generations of "Peppers," Al-derton introduced a taste so unique that that people would marvel over its secret ingredients for nearly a century and a half. The pharmacist and his Dr. Pepper can be credited with changing the face of soft drink history in Amer-ica.
